Holland bought Manhattan Island from the American Indians for \$24 and founded the city of New Amsterdam in 1624. When the British took the city in 1664 they called it New York. New York was the biggest state when the Americans founded the United States of America in 1776. It was so big that people thought it was like an empire. They called it the "Empire State".

New York, New York! The city of New York is in the state of New York. It is the biggest city in the state and in the USA. For a short time, it was the capital of New York State and of the USA. Now Albany is the state capital. And Washington D.C. is the national capital.

Over 7 million people live in New York City. Almost 11 million people live in the area around it. New York City is famous for its skyscrapers, museums and parks. It is also the cultural centre of the United States.

Most tourists in New York City only see Manhattan. And they don't usually see all of that. Most people don't go to Harlem, for example, because they are afraid of crime. The city also has four other boroughs: Brooklyn, the Bronx, Queens and Staten Island. The Bronx has one of the most beautiful zoos in the USA, but it also has a lot of problems. Many of the people there are poor.
